Today, August 13, 2020, 4 pm, CalaverasGROWN releases a complementary regional currency called MotherLodeGold (MLG). MotherLodeGold's introduction will take place during the San Andreas Farmers' Market, at the Master Gardeners' Demonstration Garden, 891 Mtn Ranch Rd, San Andreas.

MotherLodeGold takes the form of hexagonal wooden tokens that are worth 11 units each. The tokens are crafted from local wood in a local solar powered wood shop. They carry a starting value equal to the US Federal Reserve Note (USD). All interested parties can purchase 11 MLGs for \$10.

The purpose of MotherLodeGold is to incentivize investment in the regional economy, cultivate a resilient, unified community and mitigate the impacts of the current socio-economic crisis. CalaverasGROWN will use some of the funds we raised for our Community and Forest Recovery Project to make up the difference between the value of the MLG and the initial exchange rate we are offering to consumers and producers. I.E. we are using funding dedicated to rebuilding our neighborhood after the Butte Fire to add 10% to your buying power for regional purchases.

MotherLodeGold is designed to be highly attractive to both the customer and the producer. The customer can decide to invest in greater purchasing power at CalaverasGROWN businesses, using MLGs to purchase \$11 worth of product for \$10. The vendor can then either use MLGs to exchange goods and services with other community members, or exchange them for USD at a 1:1 exchange rate. Only CalaverasGROWN Producer and Sustaining members will have the opportunity to exchange MLGs for USDs.

As of today there are 99 CalaverasGROWN Producer and Sustaining Members, including farms, ranches, apothecaries, nurseries, wineries, artists, shops, cafes and more. CalaverasGROWN also boasts dozens of Supporter Members. Find out more at www.calaverasgrown.org
